URI Phone Number	Browning Hall Main Office (401) 874-2064. Available 7:00am to midnight. This phone number is to be used for emergencies only and not because a player has not called home.
Registration Date, Time & Site	Begins PROMPTLY at URI, Ryan Center Parking Lot on Plains Road at 10:00am and will close PROMPTLY at 1:00pm on the first day of Camp July 8 th . (Follow signage for US Youth Soccer). NOTE: Buses MUST park in the Ryan Center Parking Lot. Do not attempt to drive to front of building as this creates massive parking problems. Chaperones will register their entire team. Players may not register individually. Coaches may register as they arrive.
What to bring to Registration	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Roster (2 copies) with changes so noted on roster. States should use the same data base roster used at the tournament. Only those players attending camp should be listed on the roster. 2. Key/Rooming List Form (1 copy to be turned in). 3. Region I Chaperone Information Form (1 copy to be turned in). 4. Medical Release forms (2 sets). (1 copy for Region and 1 copy for Chaperone). 5. Copy of Player Insurance Card must accompany the medical release form. 6. Player's Code of Conduct (2 sets) - (1 copy for Region and 1 copy for Chaperone) 7. Player Profile Form (5 copies to be turned in.) Please make sure all information is Complete 7. Medical History Questionnaire (2 sets) - (1 copy for Region and 1 copy for Chaperone)
Meetings	Chaperone's Meeting: First night of camp. 6:45pm at main tent on field. Mandatory State Team Head Coaches Meeting: To be held at 3:00pm (site to be announced at registration) on the first day of Camp.
Rooms Keys and Meal Cards	Players and Chaperones will be two or three per room. Each person will get a key or a lock combination. There is a " Lost Key Fine " of \$50.00. States will be billed for lost keys. It will be the states responsibility to collect from the people who lost the key(s). Room assignments, keys and meal cards will be distributed to the chaperones at registration. Players and Staff MUST check out with the resident assistant in their specific dorm – turning in their meal cards and keys where applicable. If lanyards are issued, players may keep them.
Dormitory/Facility Damage	Any damage charges billed to the Region I Girls ODP by URI will be passed on to the responsible State Association(s).
Report Time for Players	All players are to be in camp in time for registration between 10:00am to 1:00pm on Thursday July 8 th - Players may not register individually. Any players arriving early will have room and meal charges billed to their state association.
Check-out	Check-out will begin PROMPTLY at 11:00am on the last day of camp. (Lunch will not be available).
Linens/Fans	Players, Chaperones, Coaches and Staff MUST bring their own sheets, towels, blankets and pillows. Rooms are not air-conditioned. Bring a Fan.

Dining Hall Information	Meals will start with dinner on the first day of camp and end with breakfast on the last day of camp. Projected meal hours are as follows: Dinner first day ONLY 3:00pm – 5:00pm Breakfast 6:30am – 8:30am Lunch 11:00am – 1:00pm Dinner 4:00pm – 6:00pm			
Schedules	The first day schedule will be distributed at registration. The camp schedule for the rest of the week will be distributed at the chaperones meeting on the first night of camp.			
First Evening	Opening Ceremonies will begin PROMPTLY at 5:15pm – (At the open space between Barlow and Weldon). All players should be on the field and ready to play at 6:00pm opening day of camp.			
Players Dress Code	<i>All players are to bring training gear, dark shirts and shorts and light shirts and shorts WITHOUT their State Association identification. Players will be given two (2) T-shirts with a number that they MUST use for the entire week. Shirts MUST be tucked in and socks pulled up. Sleeves may not be rolled up. Players may not wear slide pants or tights that extend more than two inches below their shorts. Shin guards MUST be worn at all times.</i>			
Soccer Balls	Each player should bring a quality #5 soccer ball with her name marked on the ball.			
Equipment	Each State Coach MUST have pinnies and cones for his/her assigned team for the daily training session.			
Training Clothes	A player should bring to camp enough training clothes to last her for the week.			
Items for players to bring to Camp	alarm clock linens fan rainwear training clothes	sweatshirt/jacket blister block lip balm sun screen	toilet articles personal soap powdered sports drink snacks Cleated Shoes	Soccer ball w/name on ball Shin guards Indoor gym or soccer shoes Flip flops (players should never go w/o shoes)
Training Sessions	State coaches MUST be at all Training Sessions for their teams. NO team is excused from any training session unless Regional Head Coach, Sue Ryan cancels the session.			
Conduct	All ATTENDEES are expected to Behave as Ladies and Gentlemen. Under NO circumstances will alcoholic beverages or controlled substances be permitted in dorms or on the fields. (NO cell phones are allowed on the fields or in the cafeteria.)			
Dorm Curfew	The dormitory curfew is 10:30pm with quiet time and lights out at 11:00pm . The door to the player's dorm will be locked at 11:00pm . NO ONE will be permitted entrance after 11:00pm.			
Dorm Policy	For security purposes, ONLY attendees will be permitted in dorms. Coaches (Male or Female) WILL NOT be permitted in the Player's Dorms. VISITORS ARE NOT permitted in the Player's Dorms. Please MAKE SURE all Coaches and Parents Understand this Policy .			
Camp Policy	Players MAY NOT leave the campus at ANY TIME . This Ruling will be STRICTLY ENFORCED . Players should remain with their team at all times. If parents are present during the camp, they may not visit dorm rooms or take players off campus. Development of players on and off the field is a part of the Region I Olympic Development Camp Format.
