<b>Age Group Tournament Information</b>	
<b>U13 and U14 Age Group</b> Boys and Girls	These age groups will be playing a three game round robin with <b>NO</b> Semi-Finals or Finals matches. Two games on Saturday and one game on Sunday. All games will be 2 x 30 minutes.
<b>U15, U16 &amp; U17 Age Groups</b> Boys and Girls	These age groups will be playing one preliminary game each day on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. <b>Game Lengths:</b> Friday: all age groups: 2 x 30 minutes. Saturday & Sunday: U15s and U16s – 2 x 40 minutes Saturday & Sunday: U17s – 2 x 45 minutes Semi-Finals and Finals will be played at the Kirkwood SC <b>June 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Game Check-In Information</b>	
<b>Mandatory Tournament Check-in</b>	A Team Official <b>must</b> check-in your team no later than one hour <b>prior</b> to your <b>first</b> game at the Site Headquarters at which you are playing. U13 and U14 teams will check in on Saturday morning. <b>NO Team will be allowed to take the field until they have checked-in.</b>

<b>Important Game Reminders</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Trash pick-up is everyone's responsibility. Each team will receive 3 trash bags. Please use the bags to clean up all trash in the area around your team bench. Tie the bag closed and leave the bag next to a trash can.</li> <li>2. During all games, all parents will be one side of the field and the two teams will be on the opposite side of the field.</li> <li>3. Only coaches or staff with a <b>Team Bench Pass</b> will be allowed on the Team side of the field.</li> <li>4. <b>ADHERE</b> to all <b>PARKING</b> signs at <b>ALL LOCATIONS</b>.</li> </ol>

<b>Important Team Housing Information for Rider University</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check in will begin on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at <b>1:00pm at the Student Recreation Center next to Gymnasium</b> and end at <b>4:00pm SHARP!!!!</b></li> <li>2. Key pick up is by <b>TEAM ONLY</b>. (A Team Administrator picks up all keys for their team)</li> <li>3. <b>NO</b> individual key pick up will be allowed for players and chaperones.</li> <li>4. Everyone staying at Rider University <b>MUST</b> bring their own linens, towels, blankets, pillows and soap.</li> <li>5. The dorms are not air-conditioned so bring a fan.</li> <li>6. <b>Reminder for Chaperones:</b> You <b>must</b> have your players' Medical Release Form and Code of Conduct with you at all times.</li> </ol>
